The Project DIST , "Digital Storytelling for spreading and promoting entrepreneurship" , born with the intent of awakening the "desire of enterprise" , will end in the next months.

All the DIST partners have already organized their final national conferences attracting great interest to all participants. CDi Manager was the last to organize its final conference, which by the project had to be the most participated, within a very prestigious context together with the three Universities of Pisa in Italy. It was a double event: in the morning, CDi Manager, offered a general explanation of the Project , while in the afternoon gave a detailed description of all the intellectual outputs produced, enriching the conference with two prestigious reports by two highly qualified experts , the first offered a deep explanation of the storytelling , its history and how and when to use it , and the second spoke on the corporate renewal and the fundraising. Eventually more than 130 people registered to receive the conference proceedings and the Storytelling Guide, one of the intellectual outputs of the Project written by partner Pratika and expressly printed by CDi Manager for the final conference.

The other partners also organized their final conferences , and all had great successes. The first was the University of Lodz , organizing a double DIST presentation: a first one during the International Science Week held at the Faculty of Management at the University of Lodz in Poland on 24th and 25th of April , and a second one on 26th and 27th of April , at the Institute for Regional Research National Academy of Science of Ukraine with a total of 100 registered people. Pratika was the second , on 19th of May , with 60 registered people , in the prestigious context of the University of Perugia in Italy , CECOT held its conference on 22th of June at its headquarter at Terrassa in Spain with 51 registered people, while AOA Arges organized the final conference at a luxury hotel in the city of Pitesti in Romania , on 26th of June , with 60 people registered.

All the agendas and the programs of these final conferences were very interesting and varied , and some of them were enriched with external experts invited to talk about some topics that emerged during the project works. In addition , every partner dedicated a short period of time to enhancing its unique activity , and not only within the DIST Project. Besides the University of Lodz spoke about DIST Project in an extra-European country like Ukraine.

These were the last actions of the Project DIST , with all the intellectual outputs concluded and available in the project web site (www.distproject.eu). In particular all users both target groups than lay people , can see all the videos with the interviews , available on the YouTube dedicated channel with English captions , as well as being able to download the Guide Storytelling and all the E-courses (for trainers , aspirant entrepreneurs and entrepreneurs) , with related quizzes. Thanks to these quizzes , they'll have the opportunity to receive a specific certificate of attendance for the E-courses. All intellectual outputs of the Project are also available on Moodle platform (www.moodle.org) in a very detailed way , such as in other OER (Open Educational Resources) depositories from EU.
